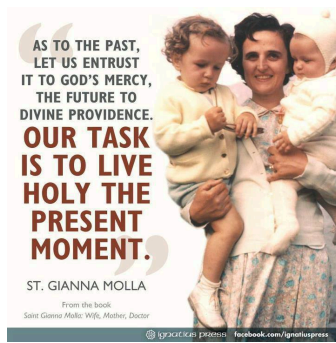

 Campers will learn the basics of 3D design, create their own personal TinkerCAD account and print their own 3D creation.

June 24-27 **Cooking with Scratch and Robotics**
 Campers will learn the basics of Scratch Coding using Scratch, create their own personal Scratch account, and use their coding skills to program a robot to follow a simple maze and accomplish simple commands.

July 8-11 **STEM Explorations**
 Campers will experience a day each of 3D Design, Coding, Electronics, and Robotics.

July 15-18 **Electronics**
 Campers will explore the basics of Electronics by building simple circuits and creating/programming circuits in TinkerCAD to perform simple operations.

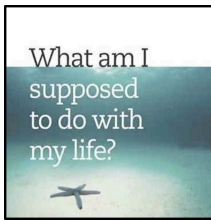
