The "Category 1 Checklist" results in a warning. However, three (3) warnings within a 9week period will result in a detention.

This checklist is for minor infractions.

The "<u>Category 2 Checklist</u>" may be given for repeated warnings and also for more serious behavioral infractions. These result in immediate detention. A student receiving three "Category 2 Checklists" within a 9-week period will receive an in-school suspension.

The "<u>Category 3 Checklists</u>" are most severe and may result in In-school suspension or out of school suspension as well as a meeting with the principal and/or Pastor, or expulsion depending on the severity of the situation.
