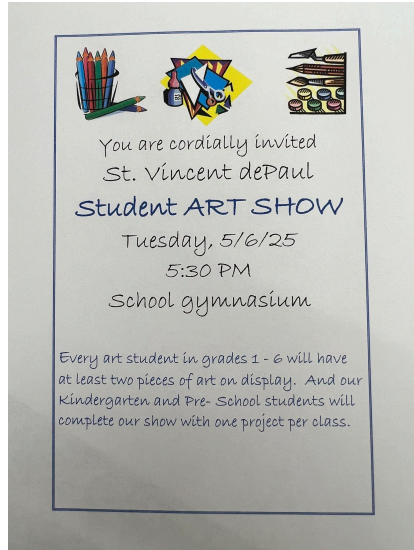

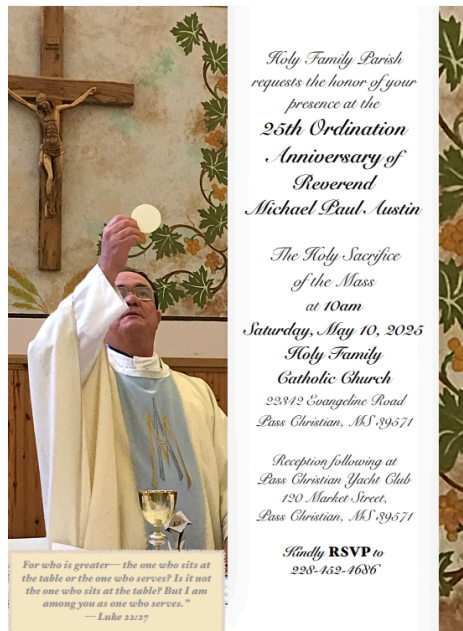

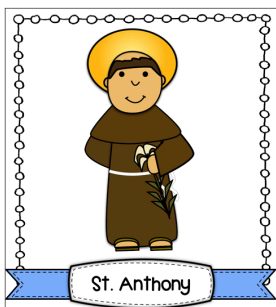

- **June 30-July 3 Coding with Scratch and Intro to Robotics**
Campers will learn the basics of Block Coding using Scratch, create their own personal Scratch account, and use their coding skills to program a robot to follow a simple maze.
- **July 14-17 3D Design with Tinkercad**
Campers will learn the basics of 3D design, create their own personal Tinkercad account and create their own 3D creations.
